THE PROJECT

The Camilleri Memorial Park and Crematorium is a project to build Malta's first cremation facility, intended to cater for the entire needs of our islands. The project located next the rear entrance of the Addolorata cemetery, includes landscaped memorial gardens spread over an area of 7,600 square metres of land owned by the company.

The goal of the project is to give greater choice to grieving families on how they wish to give a last farewell to their dearly departed. A place where the ashes of their loved ones can be scattered or stored in a peaceful and tranquil environment which can be visited at any point in time.



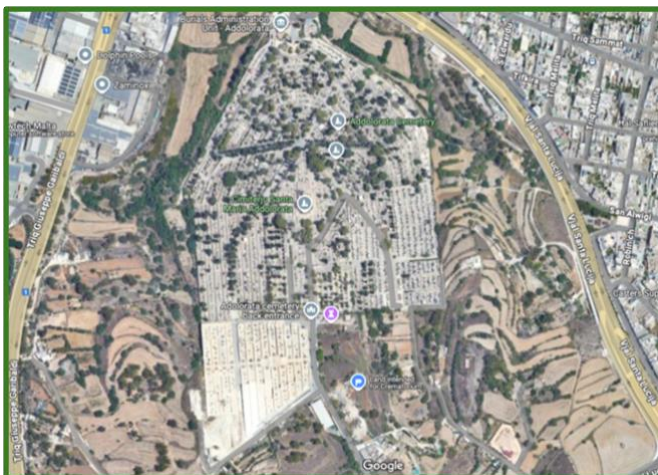
The crematorium building having a footprint of 500sqm, will include all ancillary facilities for proper care and storage of the deceased before and after cremation. It will also include facilities for the families and friends to plan and attend cremation services including a multi faith ceremony hall where social gatherings and celebrations of life can be organised during the cremation.

THE LOCATION

The project is located on the border of Paola and Santa Lucija on the main road leading down to the rear entrance of the Addolorata Cemetery. An ideal and obvious location fitting well within an area already committed to cemeterial use and falling within the guidelines established by Planning Authority in September 2024.



The proximity of this location facilitates logistics for burial of cremated ashes in family graves at the Addolorata or nearby cemeteries. Similarly, exhumation and cremation of persons already buried at the Addolorata will be facilitated.

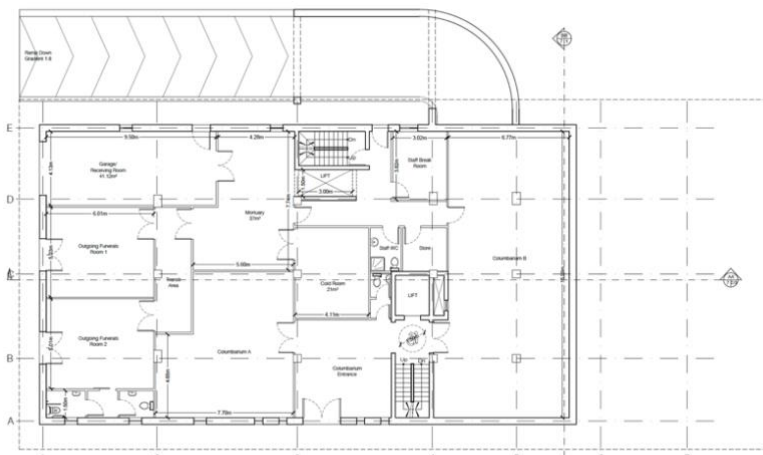
This strategic position will ease traffic for all commutes between the crematorium and nearby cemeteries while its central location makes it also easily accessible for anyone wishing to attend the cremation or visit the ashes of their loved one.

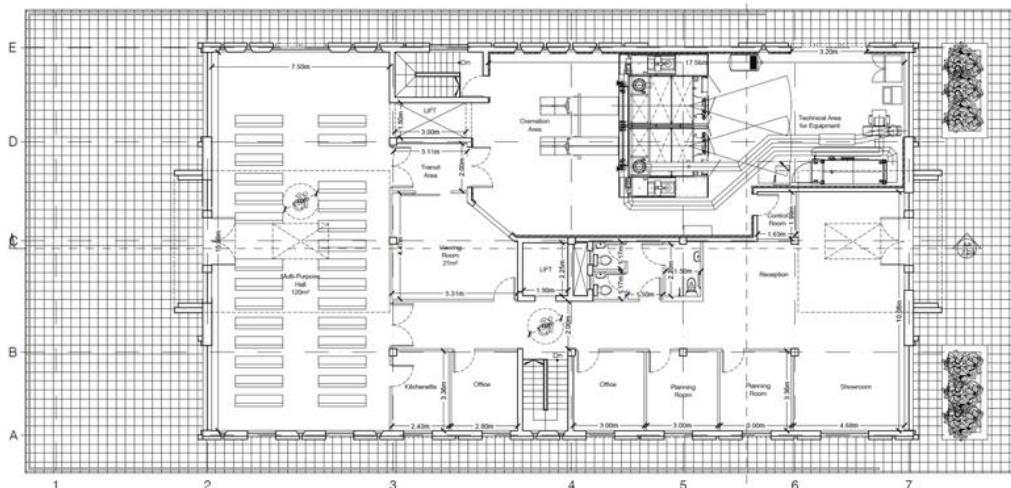
THE FACILITIES

The project shall provide all facilities to cater for all requirements in the planning, organisation and handling of all cremation services of the Maltese islands, present and future, including:

- Crematorium building including all related facilities, built over a footprint of 500sqm.
- Streamlined design blending seamlessly into natural surroundings, for least visual impact.
- Mortuary and cold storage facilities for proper care and preparation of the deceased.
- Ceremony hall and viewing rooms for memorial services, and farewells.
- A multi-faith Ceremony hall / chapel of 120sqm, adaptable to personal wishes.

Built-up Area - 500m²



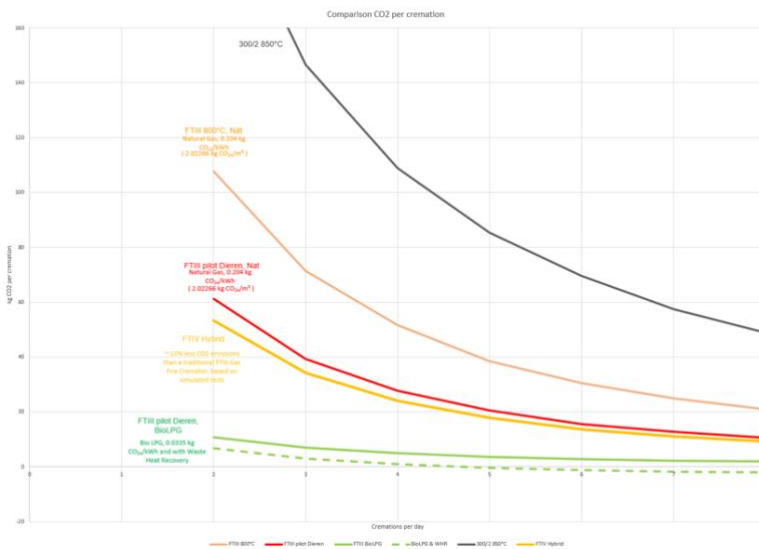
1 Proposed Level 00 Plan

- An outdoor area for social gatherings and events during or after the cremation service.
- Memorial gardens providing various options for scattering or planting trees.
- A choice of indoor or outdoor columbariums for dignified storage of ashes.
- Underground and above ground parking and space for funeral ceremonies.



ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNOLOGY

The projected cremation equipment will be pioneering its kind using hybrid technology, capable of operation with an electric power, LPG gas or a combination of both sources. This latest technology, currently in late stages of development, is scheduled to hit the market in 2025 and will be the “greenest”, most efficient cremation system in existence to date.



The selected cremation equipment and filtration systems will be supplied by a global leader in the field of cremation technology and shall exceed the most stringent environmental requirements imposed by the European Union.

Furthermore, the supplier will partner in the project to ensure the equipment and filtration systems are regularly maintained and running at maximum efficiency throughout its lifespan.

This technology, efficiency and world class support, will ensure delivery of the lowest possible emissions and utmost respect for the environment and nearby surroundings.
